This person is responsible for conducting the Sanctuary Choir (adult choir of around 20 members), and for leading music in the 11:00 Sunday service (normal attendance 125 - 150). More contemplative music is performed at the 8:30 Sunday service (normal attendance 25-35). There is also a Children's Choir and a budding Youth musical group. The Director of Music will attend staff meetings and will work cooperatively with the other members of the Church Staff to ensure that the regular worship services, as well as any special services, are well coordinated in subject matter and tone. He or she reports to and is supervised by the Senior Minister. The sanctuary has a 2-manual Schantz organ, which was both designed for and voiced in our sanctuary, and a Steinway grand piano. Our church is an Open and Affirming congregation and may soon become a Just Peace church. We accept, celebrate, incorporate, promote, and serve persons of diversity. We have a keen social conscience and a history of being liberal on race and active in Mission and Action programs. In this position we seek a leader with energy and enthusiasm, who loves a variety of musical styles and who is ready to take the challenge of growing and expanding our worship through music. We seek an educator with a liberal or progressive Christian theology, who will teach and lead both choir and congregation in new ways of expressing ideas of justice, mission and peace through hymns and anthems. Salary is approximately \$16,000 per year.
